TURKEY FACTS

Turkey is a delicious, nutritious protein. A 3-ounce serving of boneless, skinless turkey breast contains 26 grams of protein, 1 gram of fat, and 0 grams of saturated fat.

In 2010, more than 244 million turkeys were raised with more than 226 million turkeys consumed in the United States. It is estimated that 46 million of those turkeys were eaten at Thanksgiving, 22 million at Christmas, and 19 million at Easter.
